### **WELFARE OF DOGS**

Competitors whose dogs are entered at the event should take all reasonable steps to ensure the needs of their dog(s) are met, and should not knowingly put their dogs' health and welfare at risk by any action, default, omission or otherwise.

Bitches in season cannot compete

### **DOGS IN VEHICLES ON HOT DAYS**

Your dog is vulnerable and AT RISK if left in a vehicle in high temperatures. The temperature in a car can rise considerably, even on days considered as slightly warm. Please take care of your dog. If your dog is found to be at risk, forcible entry to your vehicle may be necessary without risk of liability for any damage caused.

## **General info..**

- Please DO NOT ARRIVE BEFORE 9AM and Park where indicate
- Please pick up after your dog everywhere, and take home all rubbish.
- Keep your dog on a lead unless using the exercise area or competing.
- All offers of help will be appreciated.
- Dogs must be a minimum of 15 months of age in order to compete..
- No puppies under the age of 8 weeks are allowed to attend
- Competitors shall not take their dog(s) in the ring when walking a course.
- The rings will be fenced.
- Children are the responsibility of their parents or guardians at all times whilst in attendance at 'Dappers' dogs shows.
- Judges will be supported in their role. They have the authority to dismiss dogs and handlers from their rings. With the judge's decision being final.
- In the event of incidents, or issues arising, the show managers will arbitrate, their decision is final.
- All dogs and persons entered at the show are entered at their own risk. Whilst every care will be taken to ensure the health and safety of all attendees, the organising body and show managers will not be held responsible for loss, damage or injury however caused, to dogs, persons or property whilst at the event.
- Dappers Dogs reserve the right to refuse entries from individuals.
- Competitors are responsible for ensuring that dogs are adequately trained to a safe standard for the nature and level of the competition entered.
- Dogs that are suffering from a contagious or infectious disease or have been in contact with any dog suffering from a contagious or infectious disease within 21 days prior to a show must not be brought to the show venue.
- Dogs, whilst competing, are permitted to wear a flat buckle/clip close fitting neck collar with name tags that are flush fitting.

### **PLEASE NOTE:**

- All dogs must be under full control whilst entering and exiting the ring.
- Dangling attachments to the collar, check collars, harnesses, head collars, dog coats,
- Bum bags etc: are NOT permitted to be worn or used on the course.
- FOOD/TOYS shall not be brought into the ring, nor be placed where they could act as a lure or marker
- Holding anything other than a walking aid (Except in NFC runs; where using a silent toy is permissible)
- Any person in charge of a dog is required to remove, as soon as possible any fouling caused by their dogs within the show venue including dog exercising areas and car parks. Suitable disposal points will be provided
- The mating of bitches within the precincts of the show is strictly forbidden.
- Smoking is not permitted in or around the competition rings or any of the covered areas at the show.

## Competition Rules.

### Scoring

- Bonus points will only count with a Clear round in time(60s)
- 5 faults: for deliberately touching the dog during competition in a manner which aids the dog.
- In case of the First or last obstacle being missed 5 faults will be recorded along with any further faults also the standard course time of 60 seconds will be allocated.
- 5 faults: for a hoop knocked significantly out of position.
- 5 faults: for a refusal – the dog must be in a position to take the obstacle and have turned/moved away from the line, or the dog must have gone past the point of entering the obstacle correctly and in order to complete the obstacle correctly would have to turn back. In this situation, the handler **MUST** allow the dog to continue without stopping to correct.
- 5 faults: for running past a barrel on a turn or corner the incorrect side.
- 5 faults: Dogs must enter and exit the competition area under control. A handler may keep the lead on their person if preferred.
- Time faults: - Any fraction of a second over maximum course time of 60s will be added as faults ie. Competitors time 61.5 s. faults added = 1.5

### Elimination

- Missing 3 obstacles (refusing) on the course.
- Retaking a missed obstacle or wrong direction on the course.
- Fouling in the ring.
- Harsh handling – this **MUST** also be reported to show management immediately.
- Carrying something in the hand whilst under test, with the exception of a mobility aids
- Feeding a dog entering, during or exiting in the ring.
- Starting before being told to do so, by the scime.
- Dogs running at the wrong level
- Dogs that do not attempt obstacles or ignoring its handler.
- Signs of aggression in the dog – this includes the dog biting the handler.
