HOOPERHOLICS UK RULES (effective from 1st September)

Entrants DO NOT need to be a registered member of Hooperholics UK to enter the ir first show. However, if they wish any points they gain to be counted, they will need to register within 30 days of the competition.

Veteran dogs

Veteran dogs (over 9 years) will run courses up to a maximum of 18 obstacles.

Hoopers. A course consisting entirely of Hoops. Points gained from this class will go towards progression in HUK Hooper League

Mixed. A course consisting of Hoops, Barrels, Tunnels. It may also include the Gate or Screen. Points gained from this class go towards progression in the HUK Hooper League.

Tubs and Tunnels. A course comprising primarily Barrels and Tunnels, with the Hoop as a start/finish obstacle. Points gained in this class go towards progression in the HUK League.

Starters. All dogs and handlers not entered at HUK before or have less than 200 points on the HUK Progress League. Bonus Lines or Boxes are chosen by the Judge.

Improvers. For dogs and handlers who have gained 200 points in Starter Level at HUK shows. Bonus Lines or Boxes are chosen by the judge.

H1 For Dogs and handlers who have gained over 500 points in Improver Level at HUK shows.

H2. Dogs and handlers who have 700 points or over from H1.

TEAM CLASS (if time permits)

This will be 4 dogs. 4 handlers, on a Hoopers circuit. The 4 dogs will each run a circuit around their handler in a central box. Each clear round will be worth 10 points. additional 10 points if the handler can remain inside the box for the circuit. Time limit will be 2 minutes.

- ✓ Please pick up after your dog everywhere, and take home all rubbish.
- ✓ Keep your dog on a lead unless using the exercise area or competing.
- ✓ Assistance to help. Offers of help will keep the show running.

HUK COMPETITION RULES

- Dogs must be a minimum of 15 months of age in order to compete.
- No puppies under the age of 8 weeks are allowed to attend HUK shows.
- Competitors and all who attend HUK Hooper shows will be expected to conduct themselves in a sportsmanlike manner towards other people and dogs.
- Competitors may not take their dog(s) in the ring when walking a course. Secure fencing for the rings will be erected.

- Judges will be supported in their role. They have the authority to dismiss dogs and handlers from their rings. The judge's decision is final.
- In the event of incidents, or issues arising, the show Organiser is there to arbitrate. Their decision is final.
- All dogs and persons entered at the show are entered at their own risk. Whilst every care will be taken to ensure the health and safety of all attendees, the organising body and show managers will not be held responsible for loss, damage or injury however caused, to dogs, persons or property whilst at the event.
- No competitor, spectators or any dog may enter a ring other than when competing, or when the ring is out of use or closed for breaks (i.e. lunch times), without prior permission.
- Judges have the authority to dismiss dogs and handlers from their rings. The judge's decision is final.
- The Club reserve the right to refuse entries from individuals.
- Competitors are responsible for ensuring that dogs are adequately trained to a safe standard for the nature of the competition entered.
- Dogs that are suffering from a contagious or infectious disease or have been in contact with any dog suffering from a contagious or infectious disease within 21 days prior to a show must not be brought to the show venue.
- Dogs, whilst competing, are permitted to wear a flat buckle/clip close fitting neck collar with name tags that are flush fitting.
- **A dog may be permitted to wear a visible or audible item to assist its handler in competition with permission from the Show Organiser/Judge, and providing it will not impede the dog undertaking the course.**
- **All dogs must enter and exit the ring under control.**
Failure to do so will be faulted.
 - **A toy can be kept on the handler's person provided it is NOT taken out until the dog has completed the course. The handler should keep hold of any toy while leaving the ring.**
- Competitors are to queue with respect to other competitors/dogs, allowing a reasonable space especially in the case of reactive/yellow dogs.
- Competitors to keep 6ft back from the ring boundary when the ring is in use.
- Dogs are not allowed to be lunging at the rings, other competitors or their dogs.
- All awards must be collected on the day of the show.
- All dogs must at all times be kept on a lead whilst at the show venue, except when competing or if a venue allows free running in an exercise area.
- Any person in charge of a dog is required to remove, as soon as possible any fouling caused by their dogs within the show venue including car parks and camping areas and any adjacent dog exercising areas.
- No person shall carry out any physical disciplining or excessive harsh verbal correction of a dog at any time within the precincts of the show.

- Female dogs in season will be unable to attend/compete on the day.

ELIMINATION

- - Missing 3 obstacles (refusing) on the course. No bonus awarded.
 - If the dog has taken the 2nd obstacle after missing the First and is restarted.
 - Retaking a missed obstacle, except for the starting Hoop.
 - **Retaking the last obstacle**
 - If a dog takes the wrong obstacle or wrong direction on the course.
 - Fouling in the ring.
 - Harsh handling – this **MUST** also be reported to show management immediately.
 - Carrying something in the hand whilst under test, with the exception of a mobility aid
 - Feeding a dog entering or exiting in the ring.
 - Starting before told to do so, by the scribe or judge.
 - Dogs running in the wrong level
 - Dog that does not attempt to take the obstacles or does not respond to its handler.
- Signs of aggression in the dog – this includes the dog biting the handler. Note – reactive dogs will be given adequate space before during and after their run in order to allow them to join in the fun.
