Class 1 Agility (Combined Grades 1-3)

Classes 1, 2, 3, 7, 8 & 9 are open to dogs in KC grades 1-3
Classes 4, 5, 6, 10, 11 & 12 are open to dogs in KC grades 4-7

Each class is open to Large, Intermediate, Medium & Small dogs.

The course for each class will be the same for all heights.

NFC/Training runs will be allowed (max 60 seconds), a silent toy may be used but no food/treats.

Each group will be able to course walk & run each class (one ring at a time, in sequence).

Full details of time slots and group information will be made available with your running orders.

Dog & Jump Heights

Large: For dogs measuring over 500mm at the withers. Jump height 600mm
Intermediate: For dogs measuring over 430mm and measuring 500mm or under at the withers. Jump height 500mm
Medium: For dogs measuring over 350mm and measuring 430mm or under at the withers. Jump height 400mm
Small: For dogs measuring 350mm or under at the withers. Jump height 300mm

Dogs do not need to be officially registered or measured but must have received appropriate agility training and be able to negotiate all equipment in a safe manner.

Awards

Trophies/Medals: In each class/height.

Placed Rosettes: To at least 10% of the class/height.

Clear Round Rosettes: In all classes.

Results will be combined by grade and split by height in all classes.

Rosettes & Awards will be sent after the show or may be collected at future shows.

Please Note

- Social Distancing must be adhered to at all times during the show.
- Please park where directed and follow the directions of the parking stewards.
- Please bring your own hand sanitiser and use that which is provided on site if needed.
- Please not touch anything that you have not brought with you, including the ring equipment, fencing etc.
- Nobody will handle your dogs lead, so you will need to leave it somewhere suitable for the end of your run.
- There will be a small exercise area available, please respect other space and keep your distance from others when using this area.
- There will be no catering or tradestands on site – please bring anything you may need with you.
- No camping will be available.
- If you would like to be in the same group as friends, please indicate this when entering the show and we will do our best to group you together.
- Running orders, show info etc will not be posted out, they will be available to download and print from your ASO account.
- Failure to adhere to social distancing guidelines will result in you being asked to leave the show.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Dogs entered at this show must have received appropriate agility training and be able to negotiate all equipment in a safe manner.
2. Entry fees £15.00 for three eligible classes.
3. JDA DTC reserves to itself the right to refuse entries.
4. Dogs under 18 calendar months of age on the day of the Show are not eligible to compete.
5. Dogs aged under four calendar months may attend the show 'not for competition', but are not permitted ringside.
6. No bitch in season or pregnant bitch is allowed to compete.
7. No person shall carry out punitive correction or harsh handling of a dog at any time.
8. Dogs must not wear any type of slip, half-slip collar or lead, harness or muzzle when under test. A flat, close fitting, leather or webbing collar is permitted, providing the only attachment is a plain identification panel as an integral part of the collar i.e. not attached by a ring.
9. No competitor shall impugn the decision of the Judge or Judges.
10. Hurdle Heights: Large 600mm, Intermediate 500mm, Medium 400mm, Small 300mm.
11. A dog shall be withdrawn from competition and removed from an Agility Show if it is:-
 - a. A bitch which is in season.
 - b. Suffering from any infectious diseases or contagious disease.
 - c. Interfering with the safety or chance of winning of an opponent.
 - d. Of such temperament or is so much out of hand as to be a danger to the safety of any person or other animal.
 - e. Likely to cause suffering to the dog if it continues competing.
12. In the event that the show is cancelled, JDA DTC will refund fees, less any incurred expenses, within one calendar month of the day of the show.
13. Food shall not be allowed in the ring, in hand or pockets. Bumbags, treatbags, training aids or toys are also not allowed in the ring (a silent toy may be used for NFC/Training runs).
14. It is the responsibility of the owner/handler to ensure their dog is 'fit for function' and that they themselves are fit to take part. By accepting the declaration you confirm that to the best of your knowledge your dog is fit and able to take part in Agility classes on the day of the show.
15. No dogs suffering from infectious or contagious disease or having been exposed to such disease during the period of 21 days prior to the Competition may attend the show.
16. It is the competitors' responsibility to be available for their class and running order. Full details of time slots and group information will be made available with your running orders.
17. Any handler or other person in charge of a dog is required to remove as soon as possible any fouling caused by their dog(s); failure to do so may result in removal from the show.
18. If your dog is found to be at risk, forcible entry to your vehicle may be necessary without liability for any damage caused.
19. All dogs are entered at this show at their owners risk and whilst every care will be taken, the management of the show will not accept responsibility for loss, damage or injury however caused to dogs, persons or property whilst at the show.
20. JDA DTC reserve the right to limit or close entries before the published closing date if necessary.
21. JDA DTC or their authorised agents may make results from this show publicly available and share results with third parties for the same purpose.
22. Children are the responsibility of a Parent or Guardian and must be supervised at all times including when competing.
23. By entering this show you agree to abide by government and local authority guidance regarding Covid-19 and social distancing.
24. If you get symptoms of Covid-19 or test positive (or have been in close contact with someone who has) within 14 days of the show, you must not attend the show.
