CLASS INFORMATION

**Each class is open to Large, Intermediate, Medium & Small dogs.
The course for each class will be the same for all heights and grades.
NFC/Training runs will be allowed (max 60 seconds), a silent toy may be used
but no food/treats.**

One course walking before the start of the class (no walking between heights).

AGILITY 1 and 2

A straight forward agility course, best result counts for placings.

You can use one or both runs as training, in which case please notify the judge and scime prior to your run.

STEEPLECHASE

A flowing course consisting of jumps and tunnels, no weaves.

JUMPING

A flowing course consisting of jumps, tunnels, weaves and long jump at judge's discretion

Dog & Jump Heights

Large: For dogs measuring over 500mm at the withers. Jump height 600mm

Intermediate: For dogs measuring over 430mm and measuring 500mm or under at the withers.
Jump height 500mm

Medium: For dogs measuring over 350mm and measuring 430mm or under at the withers.
Jump height 400mm

Small: For dogs measuring 350mm or under at the withers. Jump height 300mm

Dogs do not need to be officially registered or measured but must have received appropriate agility training and be able to negotiate all equipment in a safe manner.

Eligibility

KC grades apply. Dogs must be over 17 months of age. All heights and grades will run over the same courses.

NB Silent toys will be allowed for all dogs doing training runs. No food or treats. The ring will be fenced.

Awards

Agility – Best of the two runs counts for the placings.

Agility and Jumping rounds

Rosettes to 10% for each height and grade for Grades 1-4

Rosettes for Grades 5-7 combined per height

Steeplechase will be combined G1-4 and G5-7 per height

Clear Round Rosettes: In all classes

Trophies – to 1st for up to 25 dogs per class

to 2nd for 25-50 dogs per class to 3rd over 50 per class

Rosettes & Awards will not be sent on, but may be collected at future shows.

Parking: Please do not arrive before 8am and please park as directed.

Speed Limit: The speed Limit for the Venue is 5mph

Exercise Area: Will be the car parking area. No exercise area on site.

Do not walk down the yard track or go in to the fields.

Dogs must be kept on lead at all times except when competing in the ring.

Anyone found not picking up after their dogs will be asked to leave the venue.

Catering: On site catering available.



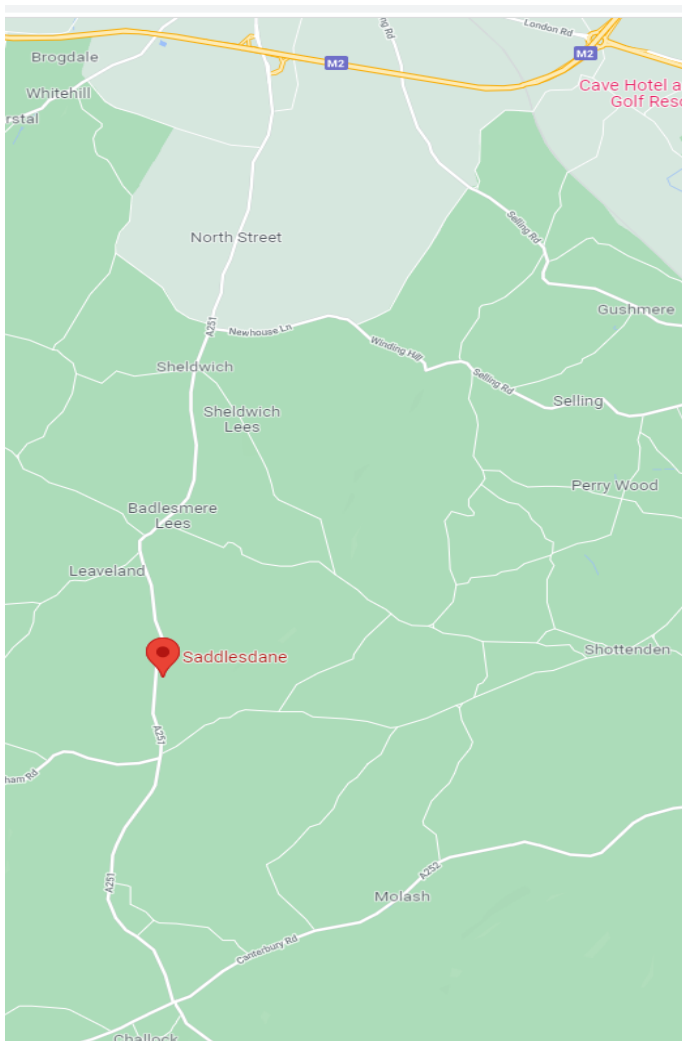
Trade Stands:

RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Dogs entered at this show must have received appropriate agility training and be able to negotiate all equipment in a safe manner.
2. Entry fees £20.00 for four eligible classes.
3. SAS reserves to itself the right to refuse entries.
4. Dogs under 17 calendar months of age on the day of the Show are not eligible to compete.
5. Dogs aged under four calendar months may attend the show 'not for competition', but are not permitted ringside.
6. No bitch in season or pregnant bitch is allowed to compete.
7. No person shall carry out punitive correction or harsh handling of a dog at any time.
8. Dogs must not wear any type of slip, half-slip collar or lead, harness or muzzle when under test. A flat, close fitting, leather or webbing collar is permitted, providing the only attachment is a plain identification panel as an integral part of the collar i.e. not attached by a ring.
9. No competitor shall impugn the decision of the Judge or Judges.
10. Hurdle Heights: Large 600mm, Intermediate 500mm, Medium 400mm, Small 300mm.
11. A dog shall be withdrawn from competition and removed from an Agility Show if it is:-
 - a. A bitch which is in season.
 - b. Suffering from any infectious diseases or contagious disease.
 - c. Interfering with the safety or chance of winning of an opponent.
 - d. Of such temperament or is so much out of hand as to be a danger to the safety of any person or other animal.
 - e. Likely to cause suffering to the dog if it continues competing.
12. In the event that the show is cancelled, SAS will refund fees, less any incurred expenses, within one calendar month of the day of the show.
13. Food shall not be allowed in the ring, in hand or pockets. Bumbags, treatbags, training aids or toys are also not allowed in the ring (a silent toy may be used for NFC/Training runs).

14. It is the responsibility of the owner/handler to ensure their dog is 'fit for function' and that they themselves are fit to take part. By accepting the declaration you confirm that to the best of your knowledge your dog is fit and able to take part in Agility classes on the day of the show.
15. No dogs suffering from infectious or contagious disease or having been exposed to such disease during the period of 21 days prior to the Competition may attend the show.
16. It is the competitors' responsibility to be available for their class and running order.
17. Any handler or other person in charge of a dog is required to remove as soon as possible any fouling caused by their dog(s); failure to do so may result in removal from the show.
18. If your dog is found to be at risk, forcible entry to your vehicle may be necessary without liability for any damage caused.
19. All dogs are entered at this show at their owners risk and whilst every care will be taken, the management of the show will not accept responsibility for loss, damage or injury however caused to dogs, persons or property whilst at the show.
20. SAS reserve the right to limit or close entries before the published closing date if necessary.
21. Children are the responsibility of a Parent or Guardian and must be supervised at all times.
22. By entering this show you agree to abide by government and local authority guidance regarding Covid-19 in force at the time of the show.
23. If you get symptoms of Covid-19 or test positive (or have been in close contact with someone who has) within 14 days of the show, you must not attend the show.
