ELIGIBILITY FOR CLASSES

In the following definitions of classes 1st prizes or other prize wins are those gained in standard classes at any Kennel Club licensed championship agility, premier agility, open agility or limited agility shows (i.e. special classes and invitational events excepted). Only a 1st place with a clear round completed within the course time set by the judge will count towards grade progression.

Standard classes may be scheduled for agility shows, as agility classes or jumping classes. All standard classes must contain the weaving poles obstacle. Standard agility classes must contain the following elements: "A ramp", dog walk and see-saw. With this proviso classes are defined as follows:-

A maximum of four standard classes may be scheduled for any dog on an individual day of competition. Any number of special classes may be scheduled.

Class Structure. A Class may either be held as a graded Class or a combined class. A graded class may be scheduled for a maximum of three consecutive grades with separate results and awards issued for each grade. A combined class may be scheduled for more than one consecutive grade with one overall set of results.

Progression. Progression from each grade will be determined by the eligibility for the class as referenced in H(1)(A)11. Results from combined classes will only count towards progression from the dog's current grade.

To count for progression wins must be gained in standard classes at Kennel Club licensed agility shows.

Only a 1st place with a clear round completed within the course time set by the judge will count towards grade progression.

Competitors will be allowed to walk the course set at small, medium, intermediate or large height without their dog(s) before the class begins. **COVID INCLUSION: Guidance has been published on course walking considerations:** thekennelclub.org.uk/agilitysecretary

Points Progression. At the handler's discretion a dog may progress up to grade 4 by winning 100 points at each grade, using the Agility Warrant points scheme (Regulation K3.c refers). A minimum of 50 points must be gained in agility (not jumping) classes in the relevant grade. If this method of progression is selected, the handler must ensure the show secretary signs the dog's Agility Record Book at the first show entered at the higher grade. There is no time limit on this progression, however once a dog has progressed, it cannot return to a previous grade.

Progression on points must be done prior to the closing date of entries. It is not possible to change a grade on points once the entries have closed.

STANDARD CLASSES

Only 1st prizes and points gained in standard classes at Kennel Club licensed agility shows may be used for progression through the classes. (A dog is only eligible for one grade). In defining the eligibility of the owner or handler for grade 1, the two wins and points progression referred to in the definition apply only to one dog and not an accumulation of dogs.

Grade 1

Open to owners, handlers or dogs which have not gained a minimum of two first places at grade 1 at Kennel Club licensed agility shows, at least one of which must have been gained in an agility (not jumping) class. N.B Owners, handlers or dogs previously qualified out of grade 1 are not eligible for this class.

Grade 2

Open to dogs which are not eligible for grade 1 or have elected to progress on points from grade 1 and are not eligible for grades 3, 4, 5, 6, or 7.

Grade 3

Open to dogs which have gained a minimum of two first places at grade 2 at Kennel Club licensed agility shows, one of which must have been gained in an agility (not jumping) class, or have elected to progress on points from grade 2 and are not eligible for grades 2, 4, 5, 6 or 7.

Grade 4

Open to dogs which have gained a minimum of three first places at grade 3 at Kennel Club licensed agility shows, two of which must have been gained in agility (not jumping classes), or have elected to progress on points from grade 3 and are not eligible for grades 2, 3, 5, 6 or 7

Grade 5

Open to dogs which have gained a minimum of four first places at grade 4 at Kennel Club licensed agility shows, two of which must have been gained in agility (not jumping) classes, and are not eligible for grades 2, 3, 4, 6 or 7

Grade 6

Open to dogs which have gained a minimum of four first places at grade 5 at Kennel Club licensed agility shows, two of which must have been gained in agility (not jumping) classes, and are not eligible for grades 2, 3, 4, 5 or 7.

Grade 7

Open to dogs which have gained a minimum of five first places at grade 6 at Kennel Club licensed agility shows, three of which must have been gained in agility (not jumping) classes, and are not eligible for grades 2, 3, 4, 5 or 6.

SPECIAL CLASSES

Societies may schedule classes other than those defined above as “special classes”. The eligibility for “special” classes must be defined by the society and included in the schedule. The word “special” must be included in the title of the class. Where special classes are classified for older and/or inexperienced dogs, the height of the hurdles, the A-ramp, and the dog walk, and the length of the long jump, may be reduced below the dimensions specified in these regulations, in which case such dimensions must be included in the class definition in the show schedule.

Marking for special classes may deviate from marking for standard classes, but must be specified in the schedule. Wins, places and clear rounds in special classes will not count towards agility warrant points or grade progression at Kennel Club shows

JEWLNICK JUMP AND TWIST PAIRS RULES

1. This class is open to pairs of the same height, grades 1-7. It is open to Small, Medium, Intermediate and Large dogs.
2. It is a combined class with one set of awards
3. One dog will complete an agility course and the other dog a jumping course
4. The judge will decide which course will be run first.
5. The agility course shall consist of 15 obstacles and must include three contacts (they do not have to be three different pieces of agility equipment) and the dog must complete twelve weaves.
6. The jumping course shall consist of fifteen obstacles one of which must be twelve weaves.
7. There will be a baton exchange.
8. A faulty baton exchange will incur 20 faults.
9. If someone loses their Pairs partner they may run with another partner provided the dog is entered in the show and in the Pairs class.
10. The first FOUR pairs will qualify for the final which will be held at Southam show in September 2022
11. Once a pair has qualified they may enter other heats for competition but the place in the final will be awarded to the next highest placed pair who have not qualified.
12. Marking will be under KC rules

The sponsors will provide 1st place trophies and rosettes to 5th place.



Juniors.

All juniors must be **under 18 years** on the day of competition. The class will be run as one combined class.

Tunnel Exchange

2 handlers must run ONE dog over a jumping course including a rigid tunnel. One of the handlers must position themselves at the end of the tunnel and one will start the course with the dog. When the dog goes through the tunnel, the next handler will take over as the dog exits the tunnel and complete the remaining part of the course.

Anysize Jumping and Anysize Helter Skelter

These classes are intended for all sizes of dogs that are not entered in any other class at this show (apart from Anysize or Veteran Classes). Dogs entering this class **MUST BE UNDER 9 years of age on the first day of the show.** The courses set will be simple, flowing and particularly suitable for inexperienced dogs or handlers, and those dogs that are unable to compete at their full height. The classes will have no weaves, tyre or long jump. The class will be run as one combined class but awards will be separated into 2 groups:

a) Large & Intermediate b) Medium & Small. **Veteran dogs are unable to enter these classes.**

Veteran Jumping and Veteran Helter Skelter

These classes are intended for all sizes of dogs that are not entered in any other class at this show (apart from Anysize or Veteran Classes). Dogs entering this class **MUST BE 9 years of age or over on the first day of the show.** The courses set will be simple and flowing. The classes will have no weaves, tyre or long jump. The class will be run as one combined class but awards will be separated into 2 groups:

a) Large & Intermediate b) Medium & Small. **Anysize dogs are unable to enter these classes.**

Large/Intermediate Anysize / Veteran Jumps will be set at 3 heights: 40cm, 30cm and 20cm and handlers may choose which height their dog runs at.

Medium/Small Anysize / Veteran Jumps will be set at 2 heights: 30cm and 20cm and handlers may choose which height their dog runs at.

Rules and Regulations

1. Dogs entered at Kennel Club licensed Agility Shows must be registered at the Kennel Club in accordance with Kennel Club Regulations for Classification and Registration B, or else registration or transfer of registration must have been applied for. The registration number/ authority to compete (ATC) number will be required for each entry.
2. All dogs registered and resident outside the UK must be issued with a Kennel Club Authority to Compete (ATC) number before entry to the show/event can be made. All overseas entries without a Kennel Club Registration number or an Authority to Compete number will be returned to the exhibitor/competitor.
3. Entry fees £4.20 per dog per class, £8.40 per pairs entry. SDDTC helping members £2.10 per class, SDDTC Helping Members £4.20 per pair. Camping £26 per camping pitch for the weekend
4. No prize money is on offer.
5. Internet entries will be accepted via www.agilityshows.online
For postal entries only, if choosing to download your ring cards you are agreeing to your running orders for this show being available to the public on the ASO web site.
6. The Committee reserves to itself the right to refuse entries.
7. Only dogs of 18 calendar months of age and over on the day of competition are eligible for competition at Kennel Club licensed Agility Shows.
8. A dog must not compete more than once in a class, including special classes.
9. Organisers of open agility shows may set a capping level on the entries to be accepted in any standard or special class, and may decline entries received after the capping level has been reached.
10. Not For Competition entries will be accepted for dogs aged four months and over. Dogs must be Kennel Club registered with their details recorded on the entry form.
11. No bitch in season is allowed to compete.
12. The mating of bitches within the precincts of the competition is forbidden.
13. No person shall carry out punitive correction or harsh handling of a dog at any time within the boundaries of the show.
14. Dogs must not wear any type of slip, half slip collar or lead when under test. A single flat, close fitting, leather or webbing collar is permitted, providing the only attachment is a plain identification panel as an integral part of the collar ie. not attached by a ring.
15. Should a judge be unable to fulfil the appointment to judge the Committee reserves the right to appoint another judge
16. No competitor shall impugn the decision of the judge or judges.
17. Sponsor at this show is Jewlnick Leather.
18. Kennel Club Standard marking Regulations apply for all standard classes.
19. Anysize/Veteran class jump heights: 40cm,30cm & 20cm handlers choice.

20. The height limit for dogs.
 - a. Large Dog classes - For dogs measuring over 500mm at the withers.
 - b. Intermediate Dog classes - For dogs measuring over 430mm and measuring 500mm or under at the withers.
 - c. Medium Dog classes - For dogs measuring over 350mm and measuring 430mm or under at the withers.
 - d. Small Dogs classes - For dogs measuring 350mm or under at the withers.
21. Judges at an Agility Show may not enter for competition a dog which is recorded in their ownership or part ownership; or handle a dog at the Show at which they are judging. Dogs may be disqualified if proved to have been handled in the class by the scheduled judge's spouse or immediate family, or resident at the same address as the scheduled judge.
22. Removal of dogs from Competition:
Following discussion between the show management and/or a veterinary surgeon dog shall be prevented from competing and/or removed from the Show if it is:-
 - a. A bitch which is in season
 - b. Suffering from any infectious diseases or contagious disease.
 - c. Interfering with the safety or chance of a winning opponent.
 - d. Of such temperament or so much out of hand as to be a danger to the safety of any person or other animal.
 - e. Likely to cause suffering to the dog if it continues competing.
 The circumstances of such a removal shall be recorded in the competition/show Incident Book and submitted to The Kennel Club.
23. Dog Agility is a competitive and physically strenuous activity. It is the responsibility of the owner/handler to ensure their dog is 'fit for function' and that they themselves are fit to take part. By signing the entry form you confirm that to the best of your knowledge your dog is fit and able to take part in Agility classes on the day of the show.
24. In estimating the number of awards won, all wins up to and including 25 days before the start of the competition (i.e. 5/4/22) shall be counted when entering any class. For these purposes a competition shall be defined as all classes covered within the same schedule. In the event that a dog becomes eligible for the next grade at a particular show, after the entry for that show has been sent, it is the competitor's responsibility to notify the show secretary at least 14 days before the date of the show. The dog will then be moved into the appropriate class(es) for the next grade. The dog must be moved into the corresponding number of classes as were entered at the lower grade. If there are fewer or no classes available for the next grade the competitor will be offered a refund of the relevant entry fees.
25. Should circumstances so dictate the Society, in consultation with the Judges, may alter arrangements as necessary. Such changes and the circumstances surrounding them will be reported to the Kennel Club.
26. In the event that the show is cancelled due to unforeseen circumstances, the society will refund fees, less reasonably incurred expenses. If the show processor has the provision to do so, competitors will be refunded in the manner in which they entered the show, but in the event the society will refund fees within 3 months of the show date to all those who had entered and requested a refund within 1 month of the show date.
27. Except for mobility aids, nothing shall be carried in the hand while the dog is under test and food shall not be given to a dog whilst in the ring. Competitors are prohibited from wearing bags or leads whilst under test.
28. Should the judge deem a re-run is required, any result and/or faults gained in the previous run must be discounted.
29. Separate entry forms must be completed by each owner and must be signed by the owner or his authorised agent in accordance with provisions specified thereon. Entry forms must be accompanied by the appropriate fees.
30. No passes are required to gain entry to the showground.
31. Competition of dogs suffering from contagious or infectious disease - No dogs suffering from infectious or contagious disease or having been exposed to such disease during the period of 21 days prior to the competition may compete. Competitors infringing the Regulation will be liable to be fined and /or dealt with under Kennel Club Rule A11.
32. It is the competitor's responsibility to be available for their class and running order. Competitors must run as close to their running order as possible. Failure to do so may be reported to the Kennel Club.
33. Animals in Event
No animal other than one officially entered shall be brought into the precincts of the event during its continuance, except any dogs registered to assist the disabled, or dogs required for educational or instructional purposes or by permission of the Board. However, at the discretion of the show society, a dog brought to the show by a spectator may be admitted into the precincts of the dog show with the proviso that those in charge of the dog sign a declaration confirming that the dog is free from disease and that the dog will be kept under proper control at all times.
34. A pay on the day class will be held if time permits.
35. A practice ring may be available to dogs entered for competition at the show, if space allows. This ring to be supervised by a responsible adult with agility knowledge.
36. Welfare of Dogs
An exhibitor (or competitor) whose dog is entered at a Kennel Club licensed event should take all reasonable steps to ensure the needs of their dog(s) are met, and should not knowingly put their dogs' health and welfare at risk by any action, default, omission or otherwise. A breach of this Regulation may be referred to the Board for disciplinary action under Kennel Club Rules and Regulations. The use of pinch collars, electronic shock collars, or prong collars, is not permitted at any Agility show licensed by the Kennel Club. This shall apply at the venue and within the precincts of the show.
37. Dogs are limited to entering 4 classes per day.
38. All dogs entered at this show are at the owner's risk. Whilst every care will be taken, The Committee and Organisers will not accept responsibility for loss, damage or injury, however caused to person or property at the show.
39. Overpaid entries will NOT be refunded. It is the competitors responsibility to check the paperwork before submission. Returned cheques will incur a charge of £5.00.
40. Competitors are responsible for clearing up after their dogs. Those failing to do so WILL be asked to leave the show
41. Competitors must follow steward's instructions with regard parking, camping and conduct within the show boundaries.
42. Goods may NOT be sold within the precincts of the show without prior permission of Shrewsbury & DDTTC.
43. Rosettes and trophies will not be forwarded.
44. No refunds after the closing date except in exceptional circumstances. Inform the show secretary as soon as possible.
45. **Only TWO dogs per adult handler off lead in the exercise area at any one time. No toys to be thrown in the exercise area.**
46. All camping units must provide their own fire fighting equipment and/or a full water bucket.

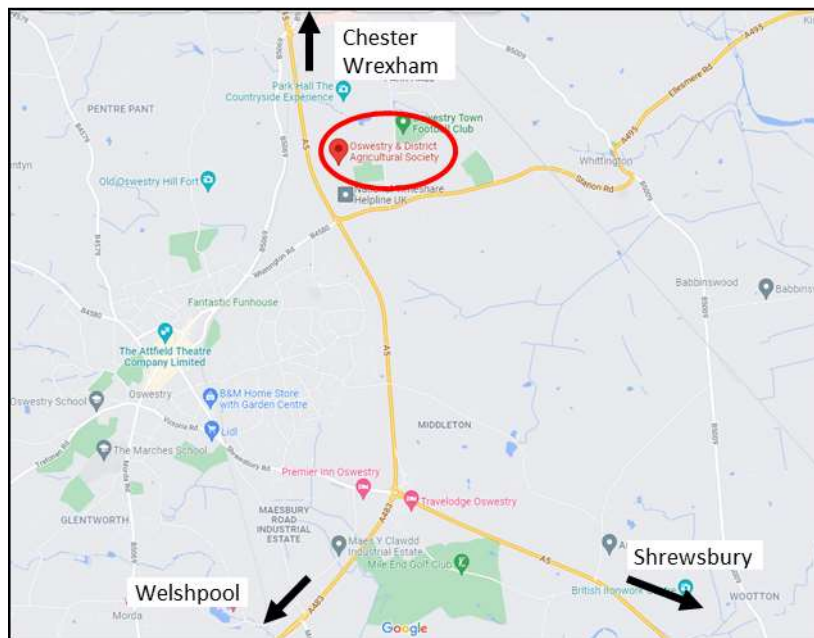
DOGS IN VEHICLES ON HOT DAYS


Your dog is vulnerable and at risk during hot weather and the Kennel Club offers the following guidance to help guide you through the do's and don'ts travelling to and whilst at KC licensed events.

- When travelling to a show please take a moment to consider whether the route to the show is on a busy holiday route and leave earlier to avoid increased time in traffic jams.
- If your vehicle is not air conditioned seriously consider whether travelling to the show is a good idea at all.
- The vehicle should be as fully ventilated as possible and plenty of stops should be taken, with lots of water available to drink.
- Ensure your dog is not sitting in full sunlight. There should be plenty of free flowing air around the dog.
- When at the show, never leave your dog in the vehicle.
- Keep the dog in the shade – take your own shade for example a large umbrella and always have plenty of water available to drink so your dog always stays well hydrated.
- Avoid your dog taking part in unnecessary exertion, or from standing in exposed sunlight for extended lengths of time. Remember, if you feel hot your dog is very likely to feel much hotter and dehydrated and this could lead to dire results
