Please note: the judges named against all classes are provisional and may be altered once numbers of entries are confirmed. Confirmation of judges will be on the ring plan which will be sent out with running orders. Further judges will be appointed where necessary.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Dogs entered at Kennel Club licensed Agility Shows must be registered at the Kennel Club in accordance with Kennel Club Regulations for Classification and Registration B. or else registration or transfer of registration must have been applied for. The registration number/Authority to Compete (ATC) number will be required for each entry.
2. All dogs registered and resident outside of the UK must be issued with a Kennel Club Authority to compete (ATC) number before the entry to the show/event can be made. All overseas entries without a Kennel Club Registration number or Authority to compete number will be returned to the exhibitor / competitor.
3. Entry fees: £3.30 per dog per class (Pairs £6.60). £2.00 per dog per class for helping Southam DTC members. Camping fees: £25.00 per space for 2 nights (Fri, Sat) or £35.00 per space for 3 nights (Thurs, Fri & Sat).
4. No Prize Money is on offer.
5. Entries must be made on the official form or a photocopy thereof. Internet entries will be accepted via ASO www.agilityshows.online
6. The Committee reserves the right to refuse entries.
7. Only dogs of 18 calendar months of age and over on the day of competition are eligible for competition at Kennel Club licensed Agility Shows.
8. Not for competition, entries will be accepted for dogs aged four months and over. Dogs must be Kennel Club registered with their details recorded on the entry form.
9. A dog must not compete in the same class more than once, including special classes.
10. No bitch in season is allowed to compete.
11. The mating of bitches within the precincts of the competition is forbidden.
12. No person shall carry out punitive correction or harsh handling of a dog at any time within the boundaries of the Show.
13. Dogs must not wear any type of slip, half slip collar or lead when under test. A single flat, close fitting leather or webbing collar is permitted providing the only attachment is a plain identification panel as an integral part of the collar i.e. not attached by a ring.
14. Should a judge be unable to fulfil the appointment to judge the Committee reserves the right to appoint another judge.
15. No competitor shall impugn the decision of the judge or judges.
16. Thank you to our primary sponsors Butchers Pet Care.
17. Kennel Club standard marking regulations apply for all standard classes.
18. The height of the hurdle must be 650mm (2ft 1.6ins) (550mm (1ft 9.6ins) for Lower Height Option) for Large Dogs, 450mm (1ft 5.7ins) (350mm (1ft 1.75ins) for Lower Height Option) for Medium Dogs and 350mm (1ft 1.75ins) (250mm (9.8ins) for Lower Height Option) for Small Dogs. Width: 1.219m (4ft) minimum. The height of hurdles for Anysize classes will be 450mm, 350mm and 250mm (handler's choice).
19. The Height limit for dogs:
 - a. Large Dogs – For dogs measuring over 430mm (1ft 5ins) at the withers.
 - b. Medium Dogs - For dogs measuring over 350mm (1ft 1.75ins) and measuring 430mm (1ft 5ins) or under at the withers.
 - c. Small Dogs – For dogs measuring 350mm (1ft 1.75ins) or under at the withers.
20. Judges at an Agility Show may not enter for competition a dog, which is recorded in their ownership or part ownership; or handle a dog at the Show at which they are judging. Dogs will be disqualified if proved to have been handled in the class by the scheduled judge's spouse or immediate family, or resident at the same address as the scheduled judge.
21. Removal of dogs from Competition. Following discussion between the show management and/or a veterinary surgeon, a dog shall be prevented from competing and/or removed from the Show if it is:
 - a) A bitch, which is in season.
 - b) Suffering from any infectious diseases or contagious disease.
 - c) Interfering with the safety or chance of winning of an opponent.
 - d) Of such temperament or so much out of control as to be a danger to the safety of any person or other animal.
 - e) Likely to cause suffering to the dog if it continues competing.The circumstances of such a removal shall be recorded in the competition/show Incident Book and submitted to the Kennel Club.
22. In estimating the number of awards won, all wins up to and including 25 days before the start of the competition, i.e. 19/08/19, shall be counted when entering any class. For these purposes a competition shall be defined as all classes covered within the same schedule. In the event that a dog becomes eligible for the next grade at a particular show, after the entry for that show has been sent, it is the competitor's responsibility to notify the show secretary at least 14 days before the date of the show (30/08/2019). The dog will then be moved into the appropriate class(es) for the next grade. The dog must be moved into the corresponding number of classes as were entered at the lower grade. If there are fewer, or no classes available for the next grade the competitor will be offered a refund of the relevant entry fees.
23. Should circumstances so dictate the Society, in consultation with the Judges may alter arrangements as necessary. Such changes and the circumstances surrounding them must be reported to the Kennel Club.
24. In the event that the show is cancelled due to unforeseen circumstances, the club/society will refund fees, less reasonably incurred expenses. If the show processor has the provisions to do so, competitors will be refunded in the manner in which they had entered the show, but in any event the society will refund fees within 3 months of the show date to all those who had entered and requested a refund within 1 month of the show date. In case of cancellation of the show within seven days of the show date, notification will be sent to the relevant websites and posted on applicable facebook groups where possible. It will be the competitors responsibility to check with these services if continuation of the show is in doubt.
25. Except for mobility aids, nothing shall be carried in the hand while the dog is under test and food shall not be given to a dog whilst in the ring. Competitors are prohibited from wearing bags or leads whilst under test.
26. Should the judge deem a re-run is required, any result and/or faults gained in the previous run must be discounted.
27. Separate entry forms must be completed by each competitor and must be signed by the competitor or his authorised agent in accordance with provisions specified thereon. Entry forms must be accompanied with the appropriate fees.
28. Passes are not required to gain entry to the show/showground.
29. No dogs suffering from infectious or contagious disease or having been exposed to such disease during 21 days prior to the competition may compete. Competitors infringing the Regulation will be liable to be fined and /or dealt with under the Kennel Club Rule A42.
30. It is the competitor's responsibility to be available for their class and running order. Competitors must run as close to their running order as possible. Failure to do so may be reported to the Kennel Club. In Championship classes competitors must run in exact running order specified in the Regulations.
31. Animals in Event - No animal other than one officially entered shall be brought into the precincts of the event during its continuance, except any dogs registered to assist the disabled, or dogs required for educational or instructional purposes or by permission of the Board. However, at the discretion of the show society, a dog brought to the show by a spectator may be admitted into the precincts of the dog show, with the proviso that those in charge of the dog sign a declaration confirming the dog is free from disease and that the dog will be kept under proper control at all times.
32. All dogs registered and resident outside the UK must be issued with a Kennel Club Authority to Compete number before entry the show/event can be made. All overseas entries without a Kennel Club Registration number or an Authority to compete number will be returned to the exhibitor/competitor.
33. A pay on the day class may be held if time and weather permits.
34. A practice ring may be available to dogs entered for competition at the show if time and space allows. To be supervised by a responsible adult with agility knowledge.
35. Welfare of Dogs - An exhibitor (or competitor) whose dog is entered at a Kennel Club licensed event should take all reasonable steps to ensure the needs of their dog(s) are met, and should not knowingly put their dogs' health and welfare at risk by any action, default, omission or otherwise. A breach of this Regulation may be referred to the Board

for disciplinary action under Kennel Club Rules and Regulations. The use of pinch collars, electronic shock collars, or prong collars, is not permitted at any Agility show licensed by the Kennel Club. This shall apply at the venue and within the precincts of the show.

36. All dogs entered at this show are at the owner's risk. Whilst every care will be taken, the Committee and Organisers will not accept responsibility for loss, damage or injury, however caused to persons, dogs or property at the show.

37. Overpaid entries will NOT be refunded.

38. Strictly NO refunds after the closing date.

39. Camping: Spaces will be allocated and each pitch will be a minimum of 9m x 10m. Units must be placed as per the map that will be provided.

40. Maximum of 2 dogs off-lead per adult in the exercise area.

41. Anyone found not picking up after their dogs will be asked to leave the venue immediately.

42. No selling of goods on the show venue without prior permission.

43. A charge of £10.00 will be made for any returned / unpaid cheques.

44. Dog Agility is a competitive and physically strenuous activity. It is the responsibility of the owner / handler to ensure their dog is 'fit for function' and that they themselves are fit to take part. By signing the entry form you confirm that to the best of your knowledge your dog is fit and able to take part in Agility classes on the day of the show.

45. If you enter the show by paper entry form and choose to download your ring cards you are agreeing for the information on them to be publicly viewable online.

The show organisers or their authorised agents may make results from this show publicly available and share results with third parties for the same purpose.

46. Children under the age of 11 are the responsibility of and must be accompanied at all times by a parent or guardian including when competing.

ELIGIBILITY FOR CLASSES

In the following definitions of classes First Prizes or other prize wins are those gained in standard classes at any Kennel Club licensed Championship Agility, Premier Agility, Open Agility or Limited Agility Shows (i.e. special classes and invitational events excepted). Only a first place with a clear round completed within the course time set by the judge will count towards grade progression.

Standard classes may be scheduled for Agility Shows, as Agility classes or Jumping classes. All standard classes must contain the Weaving Poles obstacle. Standard Agility classes must contain the following elements: "A Ramp", Dog Walk and See-Saw. With this proviso classes are defined as follows:-

A maximum of four standard classes may be scheduled for any dog on an individual day of competition. Any number of special classes may be scheduled.

Class Structure. A Class may either be held as a Graded Class or a Combined Class. A Graded Class may be scheduled for a maximum of three consecutive Grades with separate results and awards issued for each grade. A Combined Class may be scheduled for more than one consecutive grade with one overall set of results.

Progression. Progression from each Grade will be determined by the eligibility for the class as referenced in H(1)(A)11. Results from Combined Classes will only count towards progression from the dog's current grade.

To count for progression wins must be gained in standard classes at Kennel Club Licensed Agility Shows.

Only a first place with a clear round completed within the course time set by the judge will count towards grade progression.

Lower Height Option. Societies may offer the Lower Height Option to all dogs in that height category and may be offered at all grades. It is to be run as part of any Standard class as defined in the regulations and must be clearly identified in the schedule. Each relevant class will have two heights with a change part way through to raise/lower the jump heights and may extend/reduce the length of the long jump and width of the rising spread, within the permitted ranges, and competitors must run at their entered height. The order in which the heights will run must be detailed on the ring cards/ring plan. There will be only one course walking at the start of the class. In a class where the Lower Height Option is available show organisers may offer one set of awards by combining the results of each height or may offer separate awards for each height category.

Competitors will be allowed to walk the course set at Small, Medium or Large height without their dog(s) before the class begins. Hurdles may be raised/lowered during the course walking time if multiple heights are offered within the same class.

When the Lower Height Option is scheduled a dog may only be entered at either the Full Height or the Lower Height and it cannot compete at a different height in any other class at that competition, including special classes. For these purposes a competition shall be defined as all classes covered within the same schedule.

Points Progression. At the handler's discretion a dog may progress up to Grade 4 by winning 100 points at each grade, using the Agility Warrant points scheme (Regulation K3.c refers). A minimum of 50 points must be gained in agility (not jumping) classes in the relevant grade. If this method of progression is selected, the handler must ensure the Show Secretary signs the dog's Agility Record Book at the first show entered at the higher grade. There is no time limit on this progression, however once a dog has progressed, it cannot return to a previous grade.

Progression on points must be done prior to the closing date of entries. It is not possible to change a grade on points once the entries have closed.

STANDARD CLASSES - Only first prizes and points gained in standard classes at Kennel Club licensed Agility Shows may be used for progression through the classes. (A dog is only eligible for one grade). In defining the eligibility of the owner or handler for Grade 1, the two wins and points progression referred to in the definition apply only to one dog and not an accumulation of dogs.

Grade 1 - Open to owners, handlers or dogs which have not gained a minimum of two first places at Grade 1 at Kennel Club Licensed Agility Shows, at least one of which must have been gained in an agility (not jumping) class. N.B Owners, handlers or dogs previously qualified out of Grade 1 are not eligible for this class.

Grade 2 - Open to dogs which are not eligible for Grade 1 or have elected to progress on points from Grade 1 and are not eligible for Grades 3, 4, 5, 6, or 7.

Grade 3 - Open to dogs which have gained a minimum of two first places at Grade 2 at Kennel Club Licensed Agility Shows, one of which must have been gained in an agility (not jumping) class, or have elected to progress on points from Grade 2 and are not eligible for Grades 2, 4, 5, 6 or 7.

Grade 4 - Open to dogs which have gained a minimum of three first places at Grade 3 at Kennel Club Licensed Agility Shows, two of which must have been gained in agility (not jumping classes), or have elected to progress on points from Grade 3 and are not eligible for Grades 2, 3, 5, 6 or 7

Grade 5 - Open to dogs which have gained a minimum of four first places at Grade 4 at Kennel Club Licensed Agility Shows, two of which must have been gained in agility (not jumping) classes, and are not eligible for Grades 2, 3, 4, 6 or 7

Grade 6 - Open to dogs which have gained a minimum of four first places at Grade 5 at Kennel Club Licensed Agility Shows, two of which must have been gained in agility (not jumping) classes, and are not eligible for Grades 2, 3, 4, 5 or 7.

Grade 7 - Open to dogs which have gained a minimum of five first places at Grade 6 at Kennel Club Licensed Agility Shows, three of which must have been gained in agility (not jumping) classes, and are not eligible for Grades 2, 3, 4, 5 or 6.

SPECIAL CLASSES - Societies may schedule classes other than those defined above as "Special classes". The eligibility for "Special" classes must be defined by the Society and included in the schedule. The word "Special" must be included in the title of the class. Where special classes are classified for older and/or inexperienced dogs, the height of the hurdles, the A-ramp, and the dog walk, and the length of the long jump, may be reduced below the dimensions specified in these regulations, in which case such dimensions must be included in the class definition in the show schedule.

Marking for special classes may deviate from marking for standard classes, but must be specified in the schedule. Wins, places and clear rounds in special classes will not count towards agility warrant points or grade progression at Kennel Club shows.

Dogs must not wear any type of slip, half-slip collar or lead when under test. A single flat, close fitting collar is permitted, providing the only attachment is a plain identification panel as an integral part of the collar ie. not attached by a ring.

Any Size Classes

Open to all dogs not entered in any other classes over the weekend. Jumps will be set at 450mm, 350mm and 250mm. Please enter the height you would like to compete at. These classes will not include weaves, long jump or a tyre and should be a simple flowing course design. The course time will be 60 seconds. All heights of dogs will compete against each other over the same course at the dog's applicable jump height with one set of awards.

Steeplechase (all heights, excluding Anysize)

A fast, flowing jumping course with no contact equipment, weaves or tyre. It may include a long jump but course design should be open and flowing.

Dogs in Vehicles on Hot Days

Your dog is vulnerable and at risk during hot weather. The Kennel Club offers the following guidance to help guide you through the do's and don'ts travelling to, and whilst at, KC licensed events.

When travelling to a show please take a moment to consider whether the route to the show is on a busy holiday route and leave earlier to avoid increased time in traffic jams.

- If your vehicle is not air-conditioned seriously consider whether travelling to the show is a good idea at all.
- The vehicle should be as fully ventilated as possible, and plenty of stops should be taken, with lots of water available to drink.
- Ensure your dog is not sitting in full sunlight. There should be plenty of free flowing air around the dog.
- When at the show, never leave your dog in an enclosed vehicle.
- Keep the dog in the shade – take your own shade. For example a large umbrella and sheets, and always have plenty of water available to drink so your dog stays well hydrated.

Avoid your dog taking part in unnecessary exertion, or from standing in exposed sunlight for extended lengths of time. Remember, if you feel hot your dog is very likely to feel much hotter and dehydrated, and this could lead to dire results. Please look after your dog's welfare.

THE JEWLNICK JUMP AND TWIST PAIRS

1. This class is open to pairs of the same height, grades 1-7. It is open to small and medium dogs and large dogs 650mm and 550mm.
2. It is a combined class with one set of awards.
3. One dog will complete an agility course and the other dog a jumping course.
4. The judge will decide which course will be run first.
5. The agility course shall consist of a minimum of twelve and a maximum of 15 obstacles and must include three contacts (they do not have to be three different pieces of agility equipment) and the dog must complete twelve weaves.
6. The jumping course shall consist of a minimum of twelve and a maximum of fifteen obstacles one of which must be twelve weaves.
7. There will be a baton exchange.
8. A faulty baton exchange will incur 100 faults.
9. The first four pairs from Saturdays class will qualify for the 2019 final which will be held on the evening of the show. The first four pairs from Sundays class will qualify for the 2020 final.
10. Once a pair has qualified they may enter other heats for competition but the place in the final will be awarded to the next highest placed pair who have not qualified.

The Tom Greening Memorial Steeplechase

A Special Class in memory of a Very Special Man

This class is open to dogs of all heights and all grades, except those competing in the Anysize class. The course will remain the same for all grades. There will be a first place trophy and placed rosettes to 10% in each height. In addition there will be a perpetual trophy for the overall winner.

The Tom Greening "Well Done Trophy" Anysize Steeplechase

The "Well Done Trophy" was so named due to Tom's positive judging style. This class is open to any dog competing in the anysize classes. There will be a first place trophy and placed rosettes to 10% in each height. In addition there will be a perpetual trophy for the overall winner.

Large Dogs Combined Agility Grades 3, 4 & 5

Competition Rules

The "Dog Vegas Qualifier" is a competition for Large dogs, eligible for Grades 3, 4 & 5.

There will be approximately ten qualifying heats. The top 5 dogs from each heat (top 3 if the heat is split into 2 parts), will qualify for the **The Dog Vegas Final** comprising of approx 50 dogs at the July Dog Vegas show in 2020.

In the Final prize money of £250 will be awarded between the top 5 places dogs & handlers, 1st- £100, 2nd-£70, 3rd-£50, 4th-£20, 5th-£10. The winner will also receive a trophy & money off vouchers for future Dog Vegas shows.

- 1) Jump heights will be set at 650mm standard heights until Jan 1st 2020 when jump height will be set at 600mm for the qualifier.
- 2) A place in the final will not be open to dogs competing at intermediate after Jan 1st 2020.
- 3) This class must be judged under the appropriate Kennel Club Rules in force at the time of the competition
- 4) If the entry for a heat exceeds the KC limit for a judge in a day then the class will be equally and randomly split and another judge appointed for the second part.
- 5) All competitors entering the class will be deemed to have agreed to abide by the rules of the Kennel Club and the specific regulations governing this class.
- 6) The competition is open to Kennel Club registered dogs eligible to compete at Large Height Grade 3, 4 & 5.
- 7) Handlers may enter more than one dog in the competition and may qualify more than one dog for the final event.
- 8) If a dog has qualified for the final it may enter further heats, as long as it is still eligible for Grade 3, 4 or 5.

- 9) Handlers who have already qualified their dog for the final must report this fact to the appropriate Show Secretary before running in the class. If the already qualified dog then qualifies again, the place will be awarded to the highest placed unqualified dog.
 - 10) The first five dogs from the heat will be invited to compete in the final. The next five dogs will be held as reserves.
 - 11) If the class is split the top three dogs from each part will be invited to compete in the final. The next top three in each part will be held as reserves.
 - 12) In the event of a dog being unable to compete in the final due to unavailability, illness or injury the reserves from that heat will be called up in numerical order.
 - 13) In the event of a handler being unable to compete in the final due to illness or injury a substitute handler for the qualifying dog will be allowed to run the dog.

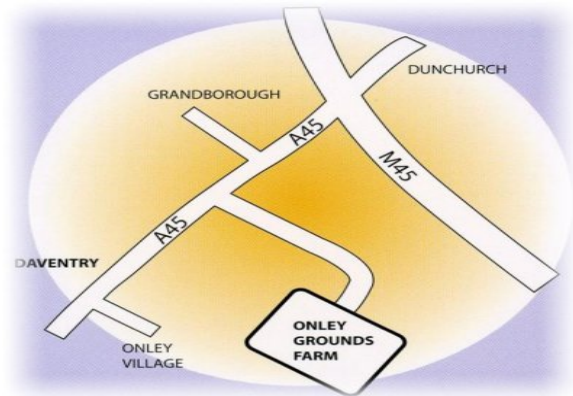
